Winterthur is the premier museum of American decorative arts and reflects both early America and the du Pont family's life at Winterthur. Admission to Winterthur includes a 45-minute guided tour of the mansion. In addition, guests may tour the 60-acre naturalistic garden (by foot or a 15-minute narrated garden tram ride), stroll through galleries containing examples of American decorative arts and the beautiful Campbell Collection of Soup Tureens, or view the special exhibits *Uncorked! Wine, Objects & Tradition* and *Made for the Trade: Native American Objects in the Winterthur Collection.* The best part: admission tickets are honored for two consecutive days – you can return on Sunday to see anything you missed!

As is our custom, Saturday evening's banquet is a black-tie event. Dinner will include salad, a surf and turf combination of filet mignon and crab cake and lemon mousse cake for dessert.
